CLINICAL FOCUS

A large part of Dr. Esgin's work concerns diseases of the retina. He assesses and treats retinal tears and retinal detachment, macular degeneration and retinopathy, and performs vitreoretinal surgery where it is indicated. He also manages uveitis, an inflammatory condition that can involve the retina and other structures inside the eye.

Beyond the retina, Dr. Esgin's areas of expertise include neuro-ophthalmology, which addresses visual problems arising from the optic nerve and the visual pathways, glaucoma, cataract and pediatric eye conditions.
