CLINICAL FOCUS

One of Dr. Eshghi's areas of expertise is exercise stress testing. In this type of test, a patient exercises under medical supervision while heart rate, rhythm, blood pressure and symptoms are observed. The aim is to see how the cardiovascular system responds to physical exertion.

His second area of expertise is inpatient ward care. This involves the ongoing medical management of patients who are staying in hospital, including regular clinical review, monitoring of the patient's condition, adjustment of treatment where needed and coordination with the specialists responsible for the patient's underlying condition.
