CLINICAL FOCUS

Dr. Kargar's clinical work takes place on the inpatient wards. Her role involves the assessment of hospitalized patients and their ongoing medical care while they remain admitted. In practice, this can include reviewing a patient's condition during the stay, following the course of treatment that has been planned by the responsible teams, and contributing to the coordination of care within the inpatient clinical setting.

The purpose of this role is to provide continuity for patients between the different stages of a hospital admission. For international patients in particular, having a physician who follows the inpatient course can help ensure that information about the current condition, ongoing treatment and planned next steps is kept consistent and clearly communicated. Dr. Kargar speaks Turkish and English, and interpreters can be arranged for patients who prefer to communicate in another language. Before a hospital visit, the Acibadem international patient team coordinates the collection of prior reports and imaging, for example MRI, CT, X-ray or ultrasound reports, laboratory and pathology results, operative notes and discharge summaries, and...
